

Part of the celebration of the City of Downey 60th Anniversary was to think about what is important now that we could share with citizens of Downey in 2056?



Ambassador Profile





Measure S

A city wide ballot measure proposing a ½ cent sales tax increase is facing the voters on November 8th. Here at the Chamber, we created a survey that was sent out to our membership so we could get their opinions on this important issue.

The survey consisted of two questions:

1. Have you read the explanation of the ballot measure that is located on the City's Web page and 2. Are you for or against the

Nearly 80% (79.31) read about Measure S on the City's page and found the information useful and well balanced. The remaining 30% (29.69) mostly used their sample ballot for their research.

The results were a bit one sided with those voters supporting the measure at 30.36% and the Chamber members opposing Measure S at 69.64%.

Many of the comments were similar. Those people in favor of the increase mentioned the need for additional officers, fear of an increase in crime, and possible slower response time for emergency situations. Those members opposed to Measure S overwhelmingly sited that the monies collected would go into the general fund and were not earmarked for Police and Fire Departments specifically.

One member sited that the Chamber was doing a very good job and they really like the Business Directory that we publish each month. Even though this was not an overwhelming opinion or a major reason to vote "for" or "against" Measure S......I thought I would pass it along!
